Subject:	Compliance in the reporting of transshipment and unloading activities of Panamanian fishing vessels of international service.

The Aquatic Resources Authority of Panama informs Shipowners, Operators, Masters and Resident Agents that, in accordance with the provisions of the Conservation Measures related to transshipment and unloading activities in ports for each Regional Fisheries Management Organization (RFMO), this Authority has adopted regulations for the faithful compliance of these measures in the Panamanian flag fishing fleet of international service.

In this sense, the ARAP through **Law 204 of March 18, 2021**, in its Article 24 indicates that *"The Authority by regulation shall establish procedures and the format of the data and information to be collected and transmitted by the skippers or captains of all vessels engaged in fishing, related activities and activities related to fishing"*, thus, all vessels at the time of performing their activities related to the transshipment or transfer of fishery products and unloading at authorized ports must report their activities to the ARAP and RFMOs..

Likewise, it is important to remember that, Article 22 of Executive Decree No. 161 of June 6, 2013 establishes that the captains of catching and fishing support vessels shall submit their respective transshipment declarations as soon as possible and, in any case, within a maximum period of forty-eight (48) hours after the transshipment as long as these vessels are Panamanian flagged, otherwise the receiving vessel shall collect this information at the time of transshipment.

According to the above mentioned, the Authority requests the Shipowners, Operators, Masters and Resident Agents, that the vessels provide such information to each respective RFMO and to the ARAP as detailed in the following tables:

✓ **Important and Mandatory**

To ensure compliance with the guidelines described in this circular, it is necessary that all vessels engaged in fishing related activities under the Panamanian flag that carry out transshipment and unloading activities in port and in each OROPS comply with the provisions of this circular.

Failure to comply with these measures will be considered serious infringements to the current fishing regulations according to the provisions of Article 145 of Law 204 of March 18, 2021, "Which regulates fishing and aquaculture in the Republic of Panama and dictates other provisions".
