Subject:	Request of Beacons, Paz y Salvo and Licenses.

Dear lawyers and resident agents, we wish to inform you that in attention to the process of issuance of international fishing licenses, according to the provisions of the Executive Decree No.131 of April 14, 2020 "*That establishes and regulates the Licenses of Capture and activities related to fishing, for National flag vessels, of international service and dictates other provisions to prevent, discourage and eliminate illegal, unreported, unregulated (IUU) fishing*", we point out that the application for the license must be submitted confirming the period of validity chosen either for the period of one year or two years, along with the application for Certification of Beacon and Certification of Paz y Salvo.

Once all the requirements have been met and the license has been approved, you will be issued a single flyer to make these payments.
